

Suggested messages to model: Bowerbird Blues

- The bowerbird is flying again!
- Is it going to be <u>down</u> here?
- The bowerbird found so much more!
- Look, the bowerbird built a home.
- The bowerbird found a friend. I like it.
- The bowerbird feels loved.

After the story

- What do you think of the story?
- I want to talk about our friends.
- <u>What</u> do <u>you</u> like to collect/<u>find</u> and keep?
