We create high quality generic (or draft) PODD communication books, as well as bespoke customised PODD books, depending on individual needs. Our PODD books are professionally printed on high quality, water-resistant, and tear-proof paper that will suit the daily needs of most PODD users. Lamination of key pages is an available add-on.

The fastest and most cost effective way to get started with AAC is with a generic PODD book. This gives you, your person and their family time to contribute to their unique vocabulary needs before committing to a more costly personalised PODD book. Personal vocabulary can still be added to a generic PODD in list areas and blank spaces provided.

Generic PODD books

Include a range of commonly used vocabulary, set out in a variety of locations to accommodate different language levels. You can effectively add personal vocabulary to a generic PODD through available blank spaces and list pages. A great way to start!

Customised PODD books

Simply modified, or highly-personalised, available for direct access or alternative access. We include person-centred vocabulary, from the school they attend, to people they regularly connect with, favourite foods and activities, as well as common language/phrases (great when multiple languages are spoken at home). *additional Speech Pathologist hours will be required for your customisations

Other PODD book considerations:

- Auditory only: when your person has severe vision impairment/blindness
- High Contrast: when your person has some vision impairment, or trouble focusing on multi-coloured symbols
- Eye-gaze: for people who use eyemovement to communicate

We charge up to 4 hours for customisation at the NDIS rate of \$193.99 per hour. We'll only charge the hours used. Invoices will be sent to your client or their plan manager for payment (we are unable to claim for agency-managed NDIS participants).

- send you a quote to review and accept
- collate your language requirements with input from you and develop the PODD
- print, hand-cut and bind your PODD book, and deliver to you when ready
