


















































Suggested messages to model: The Truck Cat

Before the story

- This <u>story</u> looks like it is about a <u>man</u>, a <u>cat</u> and a <u>truck</u>
- Maybe they go places in the truck
- They look like good friends.
- What do you think?

During the story

- Yacoub and Tinka go everywhere in the truck

- Yacoub comes from a different country/place
- <u>He (Yacoub)</u> speaks a <u>different</u> language too
- <u>Tinka</u> played with the butterfly
- Yacoub could not find Tinka

- (Question) Do you know anyone from a <u>different place</u>?


Practice with these or try some of your own.

Combine the ALD with a robust system so that you can also talk about less predictable things!









