# Suggested messages to model: Luna Roo

Use underlined words on the ALD. Also point at items on the book's page to support your message.

## Before the story

- This story looks like it is about a kangaroo named Luna Roo
- It looks like she plays soccer
- I wonder who will win?
- What do you think?

## During the story

- Look there is a soccer game
- Luna Roo is the new team captain
- What do you think?
- Look at the other team, they look ... (suggest sharing an opinion with symbols, sign or speech i.e., scary, strong or fast)
- Oh no, the other team scored a goal!
- They are saying Luna Roo can't win
- Luna Roo says her team can win
- Luna Roo's team scored a goal! And again!
- Oh no, the other team might score a goal
- Luna Roo stops the soccer ball
- Who is going to win?
- Luna Roo's team wins!
- Luna Roo showed them she was a good captain

## After the story

- What do you think of the story? (suggest sharing an opinion with symbols, sign or speech)
- What do you like to play?
- Have you ever won something?
- What did you do?

**Practice with these  
or try some of your own.**

Enjoy the story together – everyone will have something different to say.

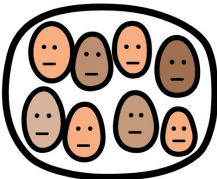
